

HOLIDAY HOME WORK (CLASS II) E.V.S

- Plant a dead dried shrub with many branches in a pot filled with soil.

Collect the various things we get from plants:

1) e.g. Pencil, rice, wheat, spices, cotton, jute, empty cartons of tea, coffee, medicine foils etc.

Tie these things to the branches with the thread and let it hang.

Roll No. 21 to 34 :- Write any multiplication table from 2 to 9.

Like, If you write 4×6 on one side. Write 24 on other side

2. Make colourful scenery on a half chart paper using cut outs of different shapes like circle, triangle, square, and rectangle.
3. Make an abacus showing 3-digit number. Make use of stick of 8" to 10" on which three plastic wire could be hung to show the Hundred, Tens, Ones places. Coloured beads could be used to show digits of a number.
4. Learn tables from 2 to 10.
