3. Book review – Read any two of the following books and write the review with the help of the web chart given below:

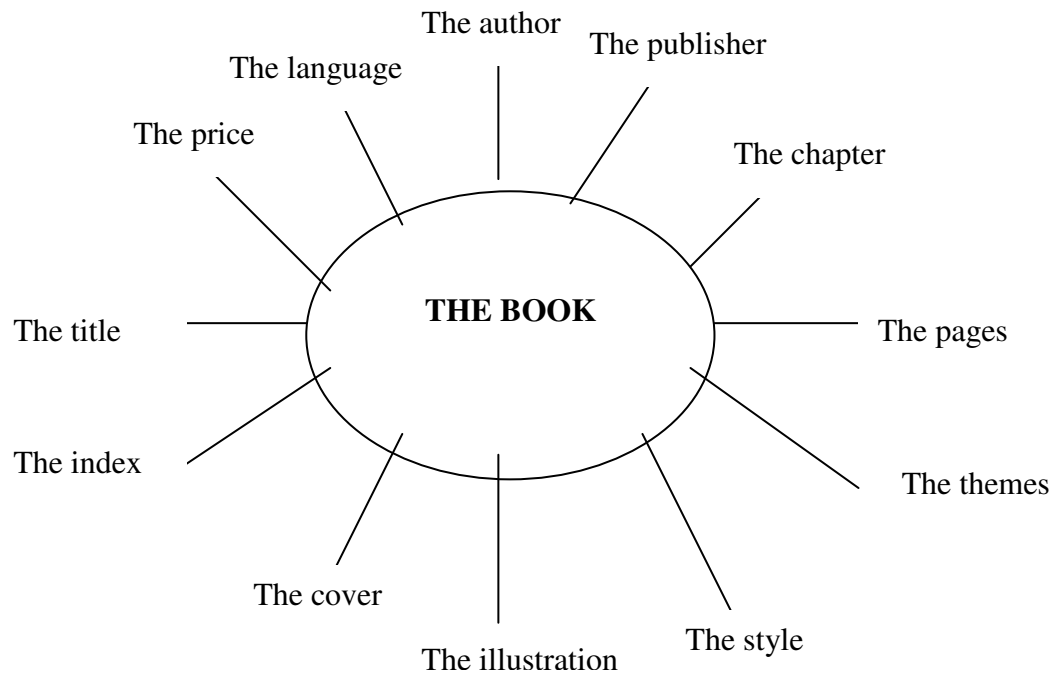
