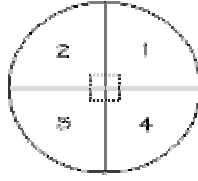

The point o, is the centre of the circle.

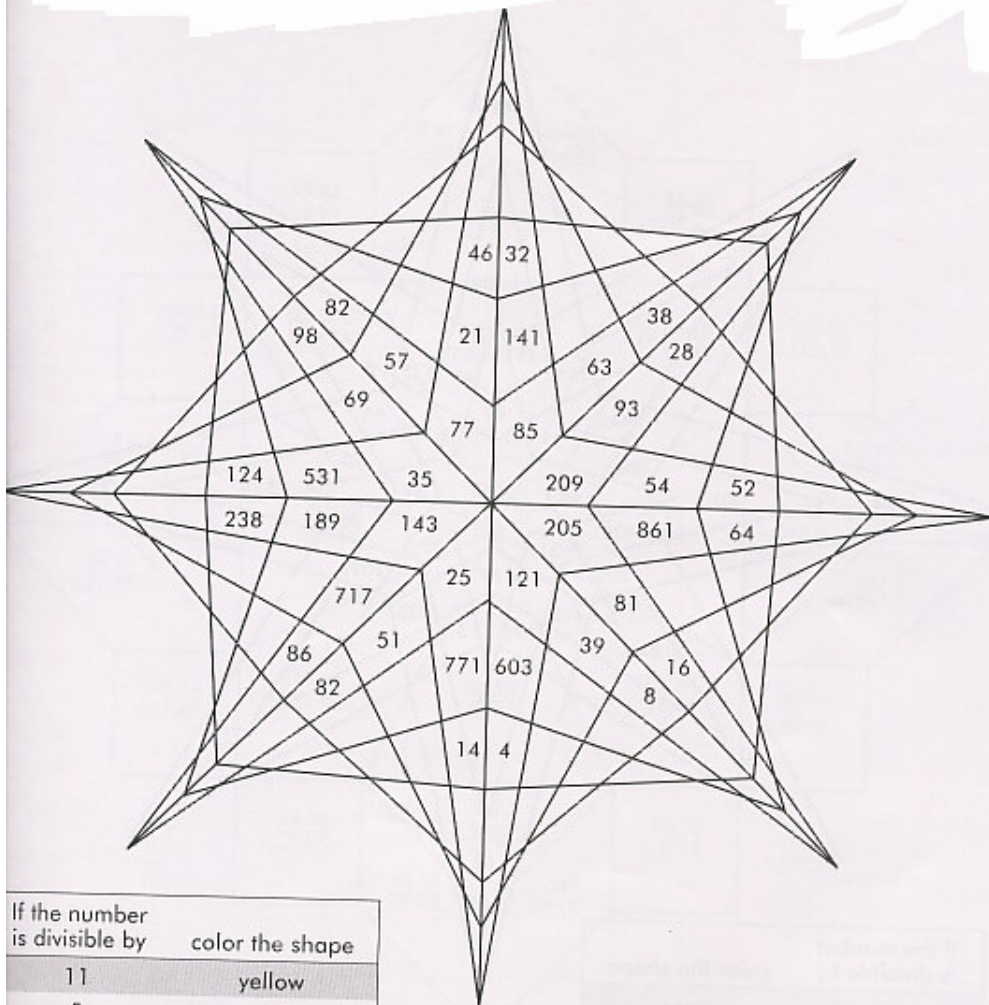
- i) Measure OA and OB. What do you observe?
