

VISIT TO THE EXHIBITION ON THE LIFE OF ANNIE FRANK



On 29th April, 2019, the students of Summer Fields School, Gurugram went to pay their homage to Annie Frank, by visiting an exhibition on her life and times, in Indian International Centre, Delhi. On reaching there, the students went through the diary excerpts, photographs and a

documentary on the life of Annie Frank. The exhibition is an attempt to show Annie Frank and many of her family photographs to wider audience interested in knowing how she survived two years by hiding in an Annexe, in the background of Second World War and the German Holocaust.



Her sufferings would have remained a mystery, had she not penned down her feelings and aspirations in her personal diary. Later on, this diary was published by her father, Mr. Otto Frank, into thirty two languages. As the students moved from one panel to another the expressions changed from sober to sombre. Their eyes welled up towards the end as they moved out of the exhibition with a heavy heart carrying lot of historical facts and the lesson of hope and glimmer amongst despair and oppression.

The Principal Ms. Irina Mukherjee, encouraged the students to visit this exhibition which was organised by Netherland's Embassy and we thank her for providing this opportunity. She also motivated the students to make diary writing as their habit and advised them to be courageous and brave in adverse circumstances.
